Charles "Darwin" Weber, age 86, of New Milford, NJ passed away peacefully on May 28, 2024. Beloved husband of 56 years to Bernice Weber (née Lucckese). Darwin was born to the late Carl and Marguerite Weber and raised in the Ridgewood section of Queens, NY. Growing up he was a fan of the Brooklyn Dodgers. After they moved to the west coast, he became a lifelong fan of the New York Mets.

Darwin graduated from Grover Cleveland High School and joined the Air National Guard while also attending New York University for one year. He was a member of the Air National Guard for eight years and was immensely proud of his service to our country.
