Chester H. Kuchnicki, 75, died peacefully on March 18, 2017 with his loving family by his side. Mr. Kuchnicki was a resident of Hillsborough, NJ for the past 18 years. He was born and raised in Piscataway, NJ. Mr. Kuchnicki was a graduate of New Brunswick High School. He served his Country Honorably in the United States Air Force during the Vietnam War. Mr Kuchnicki worked for the U.S. Post Office for 37 years, with the last 15 years as the Postmaster of Manville, NJ. He was a member of the River Road Rescue Squad in Piscataway, NJ for 15 years. Mr. Kuchnicki was a Piscataway Superchief Band Parent for 9 years and Co-Chair of Band Festivals. He was also a Little League Coach and a member of the Manville-Hillsborough Elks B.P.O.E. #2119 for 28 years where he served as Trustee and Chaplain. Mr. Kuchnicki was a member of St. Bernard Roman Catholic Church in Bridgewater, NJ.
