Gregory "Pica" Phillips, 59, a life-long resident of Manville, passed away on November 4, 2021. He was preceded in death by his father, Adolph "Ish", and his sister Dawn.

Greg was the definition of a people person, always being able to speak and make friends with anyone he met. His caring and loving spirit made everyone naturally gravitate to him. His sense of humor was unsurpassed, and he was referred to as the "Mayor of Manville". He always went out of his way to help others. Above all, he was a man who loved his family and friends unconditionally.

Greg served in the U.S. Navy during the Desert Storm War. While stationed aboard the USS Independence, he received numerous commendations as they travelled the Pacific Ocean. When the ship docked at various ports of call, Greg always purchased items and trinkets to send to his family – especially his nieces and nephews. After his honorable discharge, Greg became a lifetime member of the American Legion.

Greg's favorite pastime was fishing – either on the banks of the river or on a charter boat out in the ocean. He was also an avid Redskins fan and watched every game. He truly lived his life to the fullest.

Greg will be truly missed by his loving family: Mother, Rose Mary Silva; sisters Amy Alford and Claire Phillips; Phillips brothers Jim, Andy, David and Bob. He was a much-loved uncle and will be missed by his nieces and nephews.
