



Jerome "Jerry" Cebula

July 28, 1951 - May 23, 2024

Jerome (Jerry) Cebula, aged 72, of Manville, passed away on May 23, 2024, in Fredericksburg, Virginia where he resided for the past nine years, developing close friends with many especially Kelly Talhelm.

Jerry was a dedicated member of the Somerset/Hunterdon Bowling Association for 16 years and served on the Board of Trustees from 1998 to 2001. He attended 25 consecutive national tournaments and was honored with introduction into the Bowling Hall of Fame in 2005. Jerry cherished his time spent bowling and socializing with his friends, enjoying a Heineken and playing softball in his leisure.

He is survived by his brother, Frank Cebula, sister-in-law Mary Lou Cebula, nephew Christopher, his wife Michelle, and their sons Jason and Matthew, nephew Craig, his wife Melissa, and their son Maxwell, as well as close cousins Paul and Joseph Gabrielski, and many other cousins. Jerry was preceded in death by his father, Farnk Cebula, and his mother, Sophie Cebula (Yuzik).

Jerry's educational journey led him to Sacred Heart Elementary School and later to graduate from Manville High School. He dedicated his career to the Branchburg Public Works Department until his retirement. Prior to that, he worked in Foodtown for several years.
