John Kerecman, 85 died Saturday August 14, 2010 at Somerset Medical Center in Somerville, NJ. Mr. Kerecman served his Country faithfully in the United States Army for seven and a half years overseas during World War II in Germany. He was also a member of the Blue Army. Mr. Kerecman was predeceased by his sons baby John and by Gerard Kerecman in 2000. He was also predeceased by sisters Ann Wienewski and Jay Ditchkus and by brothers George, Andrew and Joseph Kerecman. He is survived by his loving

wife of 59 years Angela H.
