Mr. Jasontek was a member of the Holy Name Society at Christ The King Roman Catholic Church and was a member of the Manville Senior Citizens Organization. He loved gardening, fishing and hunting. Mr. Jasontek was a member of Christ The King Roman Catholic Church (Christ The Redeemer Parish) in Manville, NJ. He is predeceased by 2 brothers Michael Jasontek and John Jasontek and by 2 sisters Rose Cresitello and Mary Mauro.
