April 26, 1958 - February 11, 2025

Lynda G. (Lyn) Lonsdorf, beloved wife, mother, daughter, sister, teacher, and friend, passed away peacefully on February 11, 2025 after a long and courageous battle with cancer. She was surrounded by her loving family at the Center for Hope Hospice in Scotch Plains, NJ.

Lyn was born on April 26, 1958, and grew up in Bridgewater, NJ. She graduated from Bridgewater-Raritan High School East in 1976 and earned her bachelor's degree from West Chester University in 1979. Following her passion for education, Lyn became a respected and well-loved school teacher, dedicating 16 years to her students, with the last 12 as a cherished third-grade teacher in Montgomery Township, NJ.

In 1982, Lyn married the love of her life, John Lonsdorf, and together they built a beautiful family. She was the proud and loving mother of Kristen Lonsdorf of Hillsborough, NJ; Patrick Lonsdorf (Sophie) of Boston, MA; and Katie Lonsdorf of Bridgewater, NJ. Family was at the heart of everything Lyn did, and she found her greatest joy in spending time with her loved ones, especially at her family's treasured home in Seaside Park, NJ, and her special log home in the Adirondacks village of North Creek, NY.

Lyn was admired and deeply respected by all who had the privilege of knowing her. A fiercely loyal friend and trusted confidant, she cultivated

lifelong relationships and was a source of strength, love, and inspiration. She was a long-time member of the Hillsborough Reformed Church, finding comfort and faith in her community.

In August 2009, Lyn was diagnosed with leukemia, a challenge she faced with unwavering strength and determination. She received a life-saving bone marrow/stem cell transplant at Memorial Sloan Kettering Hospital via a selfless volunteer donor in Germany, giving her ten additional years filled with precious memories. During her recovery, she was able to fulfill a lifelong dream of visiting Ireland, a trip shared with her husband and his five siblings and their spouses. In 2019, Lyn was diagnosed with metastatic renal cell carcinoma, the disease she bravely fought until her passing.

Lyn is survived by her devoted husband, John, her beloved children, and her cherished daughter-in-law, Sophie. She also leaves behind her loving mother, Mabel Lemal Glover of Bridgewater, NJ; her sister, Laurie Kennedy (Phil) of Hillsborough, NJ; and her brother, Kenneth F. Glover, Jr. (Kelly) of Ponte Vedra Beach, FL and her faithful dog, Banksy. She was predeceased by her father, Kenneth Glover, Sr. and her loving in-laws, Nancy and Paul Lonsdorf.
