Michael S. Strickon, a resident of Somerset, NJ passed away on Thursday, February 15, 2024 at the age of 83. Born February 11, 1941, Mike grew up in Irvington, NJ and graduated from Irvington High School in 1958. He was employed by J&J Distribution Company later known as Jaydor Corporation. He worked there for 30 years. He later worked for Joseph Reinfeld Company retiring from the liquor industry in 1999. He then worked for Superior Pool Products with his final retirement in 2003.

Since his teenage years, he was an avid motorcyclist. He joined the Raritan Road Runners Motorcycle Club and soon became club president, a position he held for one year. As a Road Runner, he toured with the Club from New England to Florida. In 1981, along with six other Road Runners, dubbed "the magnificent seven" they rode to the west coast. Mike was a Charter Member of the American Motorcycle Association and a lifetime member of the Harley Owner's Group (H.O.G.).
