Mildred Nowosielski, 84 died Saturday March 17, 2012 at the home of her daughter Christine Lentine whom she lived with. She was the daughter of the late James and Mary Barnish. She died of a rarely diagnosed disease known as PSP - Progressive Nuclear Palsy. It is a degenerative neuro-muscular disease affecting the base of the brain. She was deeply devoted to her Catholic faith and with her husband were charter members of Christ The King Church in Manville, NJ. Millie quickly became involved with The Comfort Zone in Phillipsburg, NJ and spent three days a week making new friends, taking yoga and Zumba, cooking and baking, playing bingo, and orchestrating a command audience with the quick flick of just her right hand pointer finger. She also enjoyed shopping and dining out. She was predeceased by her husband Charles Nowosielski in 2004 and by an infant son Joseph Nowosielski.
