Post #2290 in Manville, NJ and the American Legion Post #304 in Manville, NJ. He was an avid Green Bay Packers and New York Yankees fan. Mr. Martinelli was a member of Christ The King Roman Catholic Church (Christ The Redeemer Parish) in Manville, NJ. He was a loving husband, father and brother and was very loved by all who knew him. He is predeceased by two brothers Joseph Martinelli and Jimmy Martinelli and by a sister Marie Malowany. He is survived by his loving wife of 60 years Josephine Martinelli of Manville, NJ, his two dear daughters JoAnn Woler of Readington, NJ and Jean Onderko and her husband James of Readington, NJ, a brother John Martinelli of Scranton, Pennsylvania and by a sister Antoinette Lynch
